Child Evangelism in Romania

In June and July our family spent three weeks ministering in Romania. A mission team of twelve short-term volunteers from Mississippi, Alabama, and Montana joined us for ten days. We conducted three separate VBS sessions every day. Our family and the team partnered with Romanian churches in Sfantu Gheorghe and Intorsura Buzaului. The majority of the children who attended VBS do not go to church, and most came from non-Christian families where they never hear the gospel message of salvation. One VBS was conducted in a gypsy village that has no Christian



church. The children in this village are all very poor and most of them drop out of school at an early age. The children were very open to hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ and how they can have a relationship with Him. Every day the children were taught from the Bible, learned Christian songs, made crafts that demonstrated the Bible

lesson, played games, and enjoyed snacks. Many of the children made a profession of faith in Jesus Christ. All of the children had the seed of the gospel planted in their lives. During the week, parents would stop by the VBS and some would stay and listen. We had an opportunity to witness to these parents, and some of them prayed to receive Christ as their Savior. During our stay in Romania, I was also able to preach in several churches as well as in outdoor settings. The Lord's word did not come back void as a number of adults indicated a decision to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Thank you for making this evangelistic outreach possible.

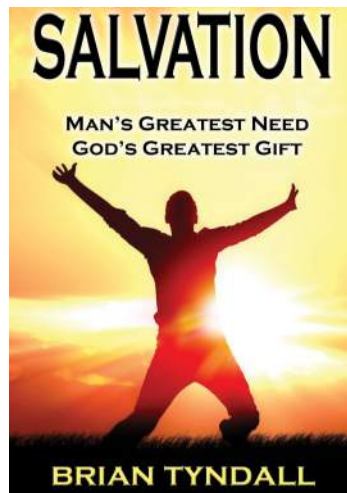
