Celebrating Two Decades in Romania

Nearly twenty years ago, I went on my first short-term mission trip to Romania. Never could I have imagined how profoundly the Lord would use that mission experience to change my life. On March 5, 1997, our family moved to Romania to minister full-time. We preached the gospel, built relationships, evangelized the lost, disciplined new believers, and planted churches. Although we left Romania in September 2004, I have continued to minister there on a yearly basis. In January I was back in Romania preaching the gospel and encouraging Romanian churches. I saw many people



that we had shared the gospel with years ago, pastoring churches, leading ministries, evangelizing the lost and doing one-on-one discipleship with new believers. Churches that I once thought would always need my assistance are now self-sustaining. God has truly honored His word and raised up a small army of faithful Christian soldiers in that area of Romania where we ministered. Our mission work

is no longer a ministry to these churches and believers as much as it is a partnership with them. I was able to encourage, train, and provide resources to a spiritually maturing group of believers. As I entered the airplane in Romania to fly back to the States, a reality hit me. Our ministry in Romania has come full circle: the evangelized have become the evangelizers. Many of you have been a vital part of those years of ministry. I understand the sentiment of John when he wrote in 3 John 1:4, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth." The Lord allowed us to help raise up many spiritual children in Romania, and I am excited to report that many of them are walking in truth.

Two New Partnerships

Uttermost Evangelism has recently established two new ministry partnerships, one in Europe and one in Africa. We will begin to partner with Mentorendist Osteurpora (Mentoring Service) in Eastern Europe and the Balkans with our first joint outreach in



Latvia this August.

I have also been invited to serve on the volunteer board of Alpha

and Omega Seminary in Jinja, Uganda. My first ministry with the seminary will be a five week teaching partnership later this fall. The seminary has a beautiful campus which includes this outdoor classroom overlooking the Nile River where I plan to teach this fall.

Returning to Strengthen the Disciples

In the book of Acts, we are told that the Apostle Paul went on several missionary journeys. He traveled from one geographical area to another preaching the gospel, evangelizing the lost, training the saved, and establishing small churches. Paul focused his ministry on people who had never heard the gospel or had had little access to the gospel. He never stayed in one place very long, but did return to the places in which he had ministered to strengthen the new believers who had been saved. Acts 14:21 says, “After they had preached the gospel to that city and had made many disciples,

they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to Antioch, strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to continue in



the faith.” The ministry of Uttermost Evangelism is modeled after the missionary work of the Apostle Paul. We are traveling to many geographical areas, preaching

the gospel, evangelizing the lost, and training the saved. We are partnering with local indigenous churches and seeking to strengthen these congregations and help them plant new churches. This year we will be returning to many areas where we have done ministry over the last two years. We will continue to reach out to the lost in these areas, but we will also seek to strengthen the new believers who have already responded to the good news. We believe this is a biblical and Christ honoring mission strategy. As a partner of Uttermost Evangelism, you are co-laboring with us just as the New Testament believers co-labored with Paul.
