## **Great Crusade in Guyana**

At first glance, the picture above looks as though it were taken on a beautiful Caribbean island during a vacation. However, the photo is actually the venue of our latest crusade in Waramuri, a small, remote Amerindian village in the interior region of Guyana. The trip there requires a six hour plane flight, two hour long taxi rides, and two separate power boat rides that take three hours. Although Waramuri is a beautiful village covered with white sand and palm trees, it has neither power nor running water. The Amerindians call Waramuri *Babylon* because its residents are known for being so immoral and sinful. It could hardly have been possible for the Lord to lead

us to a more remote and spiritually needy place to share the gospel. During the four night crusade, the Spirit of God fell on the village called Babylon. Native Amerindians traveled for up to fifteen miles one way through the interior rivers and forests to attend the crusade. By the end of the crusade, 646 adult and teenage Amerindians had publicly accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. The local pastors said they had never experienced a spiritual gathering of the size or impact of this crusade. Many lives were changed for eternity and a whole region of Guyana was shaken by the power of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.


