



Summer of Crusades in Uganda

The Lord opened the door for us to conduct four crusades in Uganda this summer. Each of the open air crusades, held in the towns of Warr, Nebbi, Katakwi, and Lira, lasted four nights. During the crusade services 2,347 youth and adults came forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. This summer was the first opportunity to utilize our own crusade equipment that we purchased earlier this year. Having our own equipment was a blessing. In the past we rented equipment and have been at the mercy of people outside of our control. We have often struggled with less than adequate sound equipment, faulty generators, inadequate lighting, undersized stages, and technicians that would not set things up on time. All of our equipment worked great this summer and allowed us to conduct the crusades with a professionalism and quality that enhanced the sharing of the Gospel rather than being a distraction and hindrance. We pray that the transport vehicles and crusade equipment will be used for many years to come to proclaim the Gospel throughout East Africa. Thank you for helping us purchase these ministry tools.





Children Need Jesus Christ

In Africa, as in many places where we share the Gospel, children are often overlooked by the church. Even many non-profits and para-church organizations that focus on children minister primarily to physical needs. However, the greatest need of every child on earth is to have a saving personal relationship with Jesus Christ. If we sponsor children to be housed in orphanages, clothed, fed, and educated, but we neglect their greatest need, which is spiritual, we have accomplished nothing of eternal significance. The Lord has given Carla a burden for these children with little or no access to the true Gospel. This summer, the evangelistic Vacation Bible Schools she conducted in Uganda, were attended by over 3,000 children. I watched day after day as children sat outside on the ground in direct sunlight and heat in groups that numbered in the hundreds to hear Carla teach the Gospel. I witnessed hundreds of children spontaneously begin clapping when Carla would tell them about Jesus rising from the dead. It was spiritually powerful to watch children bow their heads and with

innocent childlike faith respond to the Gospel and Savior they had just learned about. Thank you for helping us meet the greatest and most unmet need of children around the world.
