Don't be the End of the Pipe

When Carla and I were trying to build a support team to do mission work in Romania, a missionary friend encouraged me never to let our ministry become the end of the pipe. He colorfully described the end of the pipe as the sewer. He warned me that most people who raise support to do ministry become the end of the pipe because they do not invest in ministries other than their own. The Lord used that conversation to challenge me to make our ministry about the advancement of Christ's kingdom rather than about

our ministry. During our mission service in Romania, we supported other missionaries, ministries, and evangelistic
