Many Saved in Philippines

In January, the Lord opened the door for me and three other men to preach the gospel in the Philippines. We partnered with Rev. David Dela Paz and his church family at Shekinah Glory Baptist Church. I preached in the streets, a jail, a prison, a public high school, a church, and did an open air evangelistic crusade under a covered basketball court. Our team preached to over 5,000 people face-to-face and over 2,000 of them made a public profession of faith in Jesus Christ. We pray that many more



people will come to faith in Jesus Christ through the spiritual seeds that were sown. Our team distributed over 8,000 tracts and evangelistic booklets along with several thousand pencils and pens for children. We also purchased about 5,000 pounds of bulk rice which

the church family repackaged in 4-5 pound bags and helped us distribute to about 1,000 poor families during our visit. The Lord allowed us to minister to and meet both physical and spiritual needs in the Philippines. We also met and encouraged many new people in our spiritual family at Shekinah Glory Baptist Church. Your prayers and sacrificial financial support made it possible for us to share the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Philippines. We are already working with Rev. Dela Paz to examine how we can return next year to build on the ministry foundation that has been laid.

Jesus Loves the Little Children

In Mark 10:13-14, Mark writes, "And they brought young children to him, that he should touch them: and his disciples rebuked those that brought them. But when Jesus saw it, he was much displeased, and said unto them, suffer the little children to come unto me,



and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God." As the Lord opens the door for us to travel the world

preaching the gospel, we realize our ministry is not just preaching to the masses, but sharing the love of Jesus Christ with one person at a time. We want the children of the world to know the love of Jesus. Pray that Jesus Christ will anoint us to be His hands and feet so we can demonstrate the gospel.

Super Bowl Outreach

The week before the Super Bowl in New Orleans, LA, Carla and I and two Uttermost Evangelism board members spent the week doing street evangelism in the French Quarter. We spent the days leading up to the Super Bowl handing out thousands of tracts, witnessing one-on-one, and preaching the gospel on the streets. Thousands of people poured into the city throughout the week for Mardi Gras and the pre-Super Bowl activities. The French Quarter in New Orleans is as spiritually dark as any place in the United States. The crowds on the streets were mostly secular and spiritually lost. It was

as hard a week of ministry as any with which I have ever been involved. However, where the spiritual darkness is greatest the light of the gospel of Jesus Christ shines the brightest. We spent the week lifting up Jesus Christ,



pointing people to the only Savior and sharing the love of Jesus Christ. We saw a couple of people saved,

but mainly we planted the seeds of the gospel in the lives of many people who have had little or no contact with the gospel. The greatest battle fought in New Orleans was not on the football field, but on the streets of the city prior to the game. Our entire team was stretched out of our comfort zones and forced into a deeper reliance on the Lord. I was extremely proud of the godly boldness our team members demonstrated as they ministered under very difficult circumstances. Thank you for giving to make this outreach possible and for your prayers which sustained us during the week.
