Battling Voodoo In Haiti

Carla and I just returned from two weeks of evangelistic ministry in Haiti. The Lord allowed me to lead a three day pastors' conference on evangelism for 47 Haitian pastors. We partnered with Global Outreach Haiti and several Haitian churches to conduct two, three day crusades. I also preached several evangelistic services in two large Haitian churches. Over 350 people came forward during these services to accept Jesus Christ as their Savior. We praise God for honoring His word and drawing people to place saving faith in Jesus Christ. Haiti is a very dark place



spiritually. It is the only country in the world that has been officially dedicated to Satan. This dedication occurred on August 14, 1791, and has had a profound negative impact on the country and its citizens. It is estimated that about 75% of Haitians practice voodoo to some degree. Many have incorporated elements of voodoo worship into traditional religions like

Catholicism. We witnessed the power of voodoo during our second crusade in Haiti. The people were hardened to the gospel, and some even stopped up their ears with their fingers while I was preaching. The darkest, most ominous clouds rolled in during two of the services, sound equipment broke at the beginning of the invitation, and the vehicle we used for transportation would not start. I know many who have not experienced powerful demonic oppressions will attribute these things to bad luck, but trust me; they were rooted in powerful demonic oppression. I share this to let you know how much we need your prayers as we take the gospel of Jesus Christ to the Uttermost.

Uttermost Launches Radio Ministry

On the first Sunday in April, Uttermost Evangelism began broadcasting a weekly radio program on WSYE FM Sunny 93.3 in Tupelo, MS. The radio program is called "Saved to the Uttermost" and broadcasts on Sunday

Street Evangelism at Mardi Gras

The week leading up to the day of Mardi Gras, Carla and I distributed gospel tracts at Mardi Gras parades in and around New Orleans, LA. We concentrated on parades rolling through downtown New Orleans but spent some time in suburbs around the city. During the week, we distributed over 10,000 gospel tracts and had many opportunities to share Jesus Christ with people face-to-face. This is a very difficult ministry for many reasons. Walking long distances down the parade routes in different and sometimes difficult weather conditions is a challenge. However, the hardest aspect of this ministry is engaging

thousands of people from every walk of life one-on-one with the gospel. It requires a strong dependence on Jesus Christ and a



supernatural boldness. The range of responses from the people varies greatly between thankfulness and encouragement to rejection and profanity. We do not see

many people saved during this type of outreach. However, the Bible teaches us that evangelism is not just reaping but is also sowing and watering. The Lord allows our family to be involved in a lot of spiritual reaping during the year, and we love seeing people publicly accept Jesus Christ as their Savior. However, most people that accept Jesus Christ as their Savior have had many people sow and water the seed of the gospel in their lives for years. We believe it is the ministry of Uttermost Evangelism to sow and water the seeds of the gospel in people's lives as much as it is to help reap those the Holy Spirit is drawing to salvation.
