Investing in People and Equipment in East Africa

In March I spent three weeks in Uganda preaching the Gospel. Many adults, youth, and children were saved in the evangelistic services we conducted. The Lord also allowed me to make a major spiritual investment in future

evangelistic ministry in East Africa. First, the Lord allowed me to teach a two week intensive course on the Gospel of John at Alpha-Omega Seminary. I had eighteen students from Uganda, Kenya, and South Sudan, all of whom are currently involved in full-time ministry as pastors, evangelists, and missionaries. I taught my students that the Gospel of John was written "...that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name" John 20:31. They also learned how to teach and preach from the Gospel of John in an effective evangelistic way. Secondly, the Lord allowed Uttermost to purchase a large outdoor sound system, flood lights, portable crusade platform, generators, transport truck,



and a used minivan. We hope to use this equipment for years to come to conduct evangelistic crusades throughout East Africa. Our first crusades using this equipment will be this summer in South Sudan, Congo, and Uganda. May the Lord bless the investment that was made and produce a great spiritual harvest of souls in the future.



Amerindian Crusade in Guyana

In April I traveled to Guyana, South America, to conduct a crusade in the interior region targeting the Amerindian population. The Amerindians are referred to as the "forgotten people," but Jesus Christ has not forgotten these precious people. The Lord poured out His Spirit in a powerful way and 611 adults and youth were saved during the four night crusade. Public officials said the crowd on the final night of the crusade was the largest gathering of people in that area of the country ever recorded for any purpose. The Lord also allowed me to conduct a training during the day before the crusade for pastors and church leaders. I taught these pastors how to more effectively preach and teach the Gospel. I challenged the pastors to be more intentional in evangelism and missions. One of the local churches helping with the crusade held a one day youth conference. Over 200 youth attended the conference where I taught on the themes "Choosing Life or Death," "The Danger of Ungodly Sexual Relationships," and "How to Live a Godly Life in an Ungodly World." A great spiritual revival broke out among the youth at the conference and continued that night at the crusade service. On the final night of the

crusade a large crowd of youth came forward during the praise and worship service and joined together in one of the most powerful and spontaneous acts of worship I have ever experienced in my life.
