The Lord allowed us to travel to Yei, South Sudan, in June to conduct an evangelistic crusade. Several years ago the country of Sudan went through a violent civil war that resulted in the country being divided into North Sudan and South Sudan. At that time Christians in Sudan were facing some of the most extreme and violent persecution on

earth. Almost immediately after South Sudan became a country, it began a civil war that continues still. Instability and insecurity continue to plague most areas of the country. The people are in desperate need of the peace and hope that can only be found in Jesus Christ. The Lord opened a door for us to take our evangelistic team and equipment into the country and preach the Gospel. The crusade lasted four nights and we had over 10,000 people in attendance on the last night. During the crusade 1,527 adults and teenagers came forward to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Carla had over 800 children that attended her evangelistic VBS. Many of these children also prayed to accept Christ as their Savior. The Lord blessed us with good weather and



many thousands of people had the good seed of the Gospel sown in their hearts. Please pray that the Lord will continue to produce a great spiritual harvest through the spiritual seeds that were sown. May the Lord rule and reign in South Sudan and bring lasting peace to this troubled land.
