Olympic Games had ended, the international spectators were gone, and the daily TV coverage of the sporting competitions was over. However, what the Olympic athletes accomplished during the games dimmed in comparison to what our Savior did during the crusade services. The Lord drew crowds of people after each of our evangelistic services to accept Him publicly as Savior and Lord. People's lives were changed for eternity by Jesus Christ and the power of His gospel. During the Olympic Games people from around the

## **Training Haitian Pastors and Church Leaders**
