Missions Conference in Portugal

The Lord recently opened a door for Uttermost Evangelism to minister in Lisbon, Portugal. We were invited by some Brazilian pastors to join them in conducting a mission conference for church leaders. Portugal, like all of western Europe, is in desperate need of a revival of Christianity. The number of Protestant Christian churches in Portugal has declined from 1,630 in 2000 to 936 in 2016. Most of these churches are small with an average church membership of less than 50 people. Less than 1% of

Portuguese citizens are Protestant Christians who attend church regularly. At the same time that Christianity is declining and Christian churches are closing by the hundreds in Europe, Islam is exploding in growth and mosques are being constructed everywhere. It was an honor to encourage and train our Portuguese brothers and sisters in Christ about how to more effectively share the Gospel and reach their countrymen for Christ. The Lord also allowed me to preach



evangelistic messages in several churches, and in all of those services, people accepted Christ. We also built some great relationships with pastors who are interested in partnering with us for a future crusade in Portugal.



Crusades in northern Uganda

On June 6, Carla and I arrived in Uganda, East Africa, to begin preparing for a summer of crusades. We spent the first week getting our crusade equipment out of storage, servicing both it and the vehicles, and loading the equipment for the long drive to northern Uganda. As our crusade equipment and Ugandan team members headed north, we picked up three mission team volunteers from the United States who came to help us with the first two crusades. Bro. Ronnie Cottingham and his wife Beverly along with their granddaughter, Colleen Merck, joined our crusade team in sharing the Gospel. The first crusade was held in Gulu where 612 adults and youth accepted Christ along with many children. The second crusade was held in Kitgum where over 350 adults and youth publicly accepted Christ as their Savior along with hundreds of children. These two towns are in the area of northern Uganda that was in a violent civil war for nearly twenty years. Many of the child soldiers that have been depicted in movies and documentaries came from these towns and this area of Uganda. We saw and talked to young adults that were wounded and tortured as children both physically and psychologically during the war. It was a blessing to bring the healing and freeing Gospel of Jesus Christ to people that so desperately

need the love of Jesus. Hundreds were set free to live an abundant life on earth and experience an eternal life in heaven when they die. Praise God for the great things He has done.
