Sowing Gospel Seeds in The Big Easy

New Orleans is known by many names: The Big Easy, Crescent City, and The City That Care Forgot. In 2016 the online real estate site Trulia ranked the sinfulness of American cities based on the seven deadly sins. New Orleans won hands down as the most sinful city in the United States. There is no time during the year that the

city's sinfulness is on public display more than during Mardi Gras. People from around the country and world descend on the city during Mardi Gras season to join the locals in all types of public revelry. Carla and I spent twelve days in New Orleans this year during Mardi Gras distributing Gospel tracts and doing street evangelism. We distributed over 16,000 Gospel tracts at Mardi Gras parades in New Orleans, Algiers, Slidell, Metairie, and Houma, Louisiana. The Lord gave us the stamina and



boldness to spend countless hours walking the parade routes engaging thousands of people from all walks of life with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As you can imagine, we received every kind of reaction and response possible. In the end, Christ was lifted up, the Gospel was presented, spiritual seeds were sown, and our faith and dependence on the Lord were deepened.



Evangelizing in the Guyana Rain Forest

Guyana, a small country in South America, has one of the world's four remaining pristine rain forests. Its beauty is surpassed only by its remoteness. Travel in the interior is possible almost exclusively by boat on the country's hundreds of rivers. My friend, Ben Yantis, and I traveled to this remote mission field a few weeks ago where we were able to distribute Gospel tracts, reading glasses, children's clothes, and well drilling equipment. The Lord also allowed us to conduct evangelistic services in four locations. People were saved at each service. The main purpose of our mission was to do advanced planning for a large mission team coming from the USA. To that end, we located drilling sites for new water wells and building sites for two new churches and secured materials and transport for the materials needed for these projects. We also met with local village pastors as we made plans for two separate pastor training conferences the team will conduct when it arrives. The most remote area we visited had 21 villages in a localized area with no Christian church. Jehovah's Witnesses had one building in this area with no Protestant evangelical church at all. We purchased

a piece of property in the central village of this area where a facility will be built that will become the hub for Christian outreach to these villages. Praise God for all He accomplished and will accomplish for His glory through this outreach.
