Many Saved in Ugandan Crusades

In February and March, the Lord allowed Uttermost Evangelism to conduct two more crusades in Uganda, this time targeting a heavily Muslim area of the country. Although the majority of Uganda's population is not Muslim, there are towns and regions of the country that are. The spiritual need in these areas is great, but little Christian outreach occurs

there because of the strong opposition to the Gospel and the lack of response by the people. The areas in which we were working are also strongholds for witchcraft. The vast majority of families in the areas where we held the crusades practice witchcraft in addition to any other religions with which they may affiliate. Every town and village in that area of the country has at least one witch-doctor, and populated areas have several. The pervasiveness of witchcraft and Islam made these crusades very difficult. However, the power of the Gospel was evident in both crusades as the Lord drew people to Himself for salvation and 745 adults and youth accepted Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Several nights I watched as men and women came forward at the invitation, only to be dragged back by family and friends who opposed the decision they were making for Christ. Most of us



cannot fathom how hard it is for people in areas like this to take a public stand for Jesus. Thank you for partnering with us to take the Gospel to people in darkness around the world.



Children Love to Hear the Gospel

During the two Ugandan crusades Carla conducted evangelistic VBS for children in the afternoon on the crusade grounds prior to the crusades. On sunny days the weather was hot and the kids sat on tarps in the direct sunlight. Some days were rainy and the ground was muddy and nasty. However, despite the conditions, there were always kids on the crusade grounds when we arrived waving and running after the van. The children love to sing, and they are eager to learn the Christian songs. Carla does not do just a short devotion or Bible story time with these kids. She normally teaches a lesson of about 45 minutes in which she shares the Bible and the Gospel in great detail each day. I am always amazed that she can keep the attention of hundreds of children, ranging in age from infant to 12 years old, all seated in one mass group. Carla truly has a heart for the children and has been gifted and anointed by God to evangelize them. Although, we do not try to keep up with the number of children saved as we do with the adults, I will not be surprised if, one

day when I get to Heaven, the Lord tells me she led more people to Christ than I did. The Bible is clear that Jesus did not try to stop the children from coming to Him, and He rebuked His disciples when they tried to hinder the children from doing so. Sharing the Gospel with children has become a major aspect of our ministry. Many of the children we share with have never heard the true Gospel in their lives. Thank you for joining with us to help bring children to Jesus.
