Thousands Accept Christ in Pakistan

The Lord blessed our evangelistic outreach to Pakistan in an amazing way. We focused our multiple outreach events in and around the city of Lahore, a city of over ten million people, of whom 97% are Muslim. Pakistan has some of the most strict religious laws in the world. For example, to speak disparagingly about Islam, Muhammad, or the Quran is a crime punishable by death. Pakistan also has a large number of radical terrorist groups that routinely target Christians, Christian churches, and religious events. However, the majority of the population are simple, family oriented people trying to make better lives for themselves and their families. Many are disillusioned with their religion and very open, even eager, to hear about Jesus Christ and the Gospel. We could not use the term crusade, so we promoted our outreach events as prayer festivals. Tens of thousands of people attended our multiple outreach events and several thousand responded publicly accepting Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. We were blessed to partner with pastor Imran Fazal and his family in Lahore and



their church of over ten thousand members. The Lord also opened the door to conduct a church leadership conference for about two hundred pastors and church leaders. It was a joy to worship with these Pakistani brothers and sisters in Christ and to challenge them to reach their nation with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



Signs of Spiritual Awakening in Portugal

Portugal is one of the least evangelized countries in Europe with only one percent of the population actively attending a Protestant evangelical church. In May, I conducted seven evangelistic services in different locations in Portugal. A few weeks prior to my visit, Franklin Graham, had conducted a Gospel Festival in the capital city, Lisbon. The Festival which had been planned for two years was scheduled to run for only two nights. However, the outreach was so well received and so well attended that the organizers extended the event two extra nights. During those four nights, over 23,000 people attended the festival, and around 1,500 made a decision to accept Christ. As a result, when I reached Portugal, I found an excitement for the Gospel and evangelism I had not previously experienced in that country. During the seven evangelistic services I preached, over 100 adults and youth publicly accepted Christ as Savior and Lord. Since I left Portugal, many Christian churches have come together for a march for Jesus rally in Lisbon. Pray that the

spirit of revival that is sweeping Portugal will continue and expand.
