First Crusade in Bolivia

The Lord used our ministry partners in Brazil to open a door for ministry in Bolivia. After concluding our outreach in Brazil in September, several of our Brazilian crusade team members traveled with us to Tarija, Bolivia, where we partnered with local churches to conduct a crusade in that city. Restrictive government laws and a church culture that historically discourages cooperation among churches were just some of the barriers we faced. However, the Lord blessed the crusade and helped us overcome every obstacle. The crusade was held in an outdoor covered venue typically used for secular music



concerts. The churches that partnered with us provided a praise team, choir, band, orchestra, ushers, counselors, and stage workers for the crusade. During both nights of the crusade, the front of the crusade ground was filled with people coming forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. I am excited to report that the Bolivian churches are doing an excellent job of following up with the new converts. In the last few days, we have received pictures and reports of people being baptized in local churches who were saved during the crusade. We are always excited to hear these reports because it demonstrates that the crusades are producing spiritual fruit that remains.



Street Crusade in Brazil

In September, the Lord opened the door for us to conduct a crusade in Maua, Brazil, a city with a population of around 500,000 people. The Lord gave us favor with the local government officials who granted permission for the crusade to be held in a public area of the city. They also allowed some major roads to be blocked off to make room for the crusade platform and extra seating for those attending the services. The crusade had strong local support as churches in the area provided volunteers for the mass choir, orchestra, ushers, and counselors. The Lord blessed us with good weather and good attendance. It is always a joy to see youth and adults come forward publicly to receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Every person who accepted Christ filled out a commitment card, received counseling at the crusade, and was given a copy of my book, Salvation: Man's Greatest Need-God's Greatest Gift, in the Portuguese language. In the days after the crusade, I preached one day evangelistic harvest services in

several local churches. The Holy Spirit moved powerfully in these services and many more people were saved. We thank God for you, our ministry partners, who make evangelistic outreaches like this possible.
