



Ministry Relationships Foster Revival in Romania

We were so excited to be invited to Romania this fall to conduct a series of evangelistic services in the city of Fagaras with Pastor Groza, whom I met over twenty years ago when our family moved to Romania to be missionaries. During our years in Romania, Pastor Groza invited me to preach many times in his church. In addition, his church also hosted several of our short-term volunteer medical teams. We watched the Lord grow this assembly of believers from a small house church on the outskirts of the city to a thriving congregation in a new facility in the heart of Fagaras. During our outreach, we conducted special evangelistic services targeting teenagers, women, and the community at large.



Romanian church culture does not typically involve a public invitation in the worship service. As a result, it is not easy to get Romanians to come forward publicly to acknowledge a decision to accept Christ. We were blessed to see the Lord overcome these strong cultural barriers as adults and youth came forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.



First Outreach in Moldova

While ministering in eastern Europe this fall, the Lord opened the door for us to share the Gospel in Moldova. It was our first time to visit and minister in this country. A dear friend of ours from Romania, Marius Chiciudean, who leads a ministry called Mentoring Ministry Eastern Europe laid the groundwork for us to take the Gospel into Moldova. Marius was my translator 23 years ago on my first mission trip to Romania. On this recent outreach, Marius' 17 year old son traveled with us and served as my translator. It is a joy to serve God over a lifetime and watch how He grows, matures, and uses our partners in ministry. During our ministry in Moldova we conducted two evangelistic outreaches in the towns of Rumeantev and Cahul. The Lord drew people to Himself for salvation in both of these towns. We also conducted a three day Bible conference for pastors and church leaders teaching the "Essentials of the Gospel". Most of these church leaders have little formal training and were excited and eager to soak up every word of

the teaching. Pray that the Lord will multiply our efforts as these church leaders take what they have learned back to their churches and communities throughout Moldova.



Salvation Book in Spanish

We are excited to announce that Brian's book, "Salvation: Man's Greatest Need God's Greatest Gift" has been translated into Spanish. Ten thousand copies of the book are being printed in Bolivia, and we expect to receive them before Christmas. The Lord raised up ministry partners in the United States, Brazil, and Bolivia who gave sacrificially to make this evangelistic tool available in the Spanish language.
