Rhino Refugee Settlement Crusade

Carla and I are currently in East Africa conducting crusades in Uganda and Tanzania. Our first crusade of the summer was held in the West Nile region of Uganda in the Rhino Refugee Settlement which was opened in 1980, but has continued to be expanded through the years. The last expansion occurred in 2017 to

accommodate refugees fleeing civil war in South Sudan. There are currently 116,000 refugees in the camp, which covers a vast remote area of land. The Lord blessed the crusade with good weather and growing crowds during the four nights. Over 5,000 people were in attendance on the last night. During the four day crusade 559 youth and adults came forward to publicly accept Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. We were excited to have Rev. Brian Sansing, Mark Gregory, and Ryan Winter from Green Valley



Baptist Church in Pontotoc, Mississippi, join our team for this crusade. Thank you for holding the ropes for our family and Uttermost Evangelism. The Lord is using our ministry partnership to help uplift Jesus and spread the Gospel around the world.



Refugee Children Receive Hope

Each day before the Rhino Refugee Settlement crusade, our team conducted an evangelistic VBS for children 12 years old and younger. On the last day over 800 children attended the program. They enjoyed learning and singing new Christian songs, listening to Gospel centered Bible stories, and coloring Gospel tract presentation coloring sheets. The children love and value their special time to hear about Jesus and the Gospel. It never ceases to amaze me that we hand out hundreds of pieces of printed material to the children daily, and you never see a single piece of paper on the ground after the crusade. All the children take their materials home to show their parents and display in their homes. Children in the camp have experienced extreme violence and death, have been uprooted from their homes, and have had to flee for their

lives. However, it is a joy to see how Jesus and the Gospel bring smiles and joy to their young lives.
