


Taking Crusades to Tanzania

In July, the Lord allowed us to take our crusade equipment back to Tanzania to conduct two more crusades. We held eight nights of crusade in Sengerema and Katoro, Tanzania. This was our third journey into the country where we conducted our sixth and seventh crusades. It was a long two day drive from where we keep our crusade equipment in Jinja, Uganda, to the crusade venues in Tanzania. We spent half a day at the border crossing overcoming harassment and delays from customs

and immigration officials. Once we finally entered the country, our truck was stopped repeatedly every few miles by police to check our paperwork and look for reasons to fine us and delay our journey. The Lord gave us the victory over every obstacle. Our hearts were encouraged when we saw the Lord drawing crowds of children, youth, and adults to the crusade ground. Carla had large crowds for the children's program each day with over 700 children on the highest attendance day for the children's evangelistic VBS. Thousands of people attended the crusade services and 1,055 youth and adults along with hundreds of children accepted Christ publicly during the two crusades. Thank you for partnering with us to take the life changing Gospel to these uttermost areas of Tanzania. You have had a vital part in every life that has been changed for the glory of God!
