## **Social Media Evangelism**

Like most churches, businesses, and families, Uttermost Evangelism has been greatly affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. Most of our regularly scheduled ministry over the past few months has been canceled due to both

travel and crowd restrictions. I asked the Lord to show me how to continue to reach people with the Gospel during these trying days. He led me to contact many of our ministry partners around the world and challenge them to record a five minute video which would both encourage people dealing with the pandemic and also share the Gospel of Jesus Christ in their native language. We then could promote those videos on social media platforms. I recorded an English outreach video, and we received videos in 13 foreign languages, which we paid to promote on Facebook in 57 countries. The outreach lasted seven weeks and the videos were viewed 4,643,740 times. The videos



were "liked" 45,728 times, "shared" 14,558 times, and "commented on" 6,459 times. We were excited that people contacted us and our ministry partners from numerous countries to let us know that after watching one of the videos, they accepted Christ as Savior. The Lord blessed us to be able to share the Gospel with millions of people around the world during a time that the devil tried to shut down our ministry. Praise the Lord!
