## Kahama, Tanzania Crusade

Our last crusade of the year was held in Kahama, Tanzania, an area with a high percentage of Muslims in the population. A majority of people there, regardless of their stated religion, also practice local African religions and

still consult local witch doctors. Many Christian church members and even some pastors still believe in the witch doctors' powers and consult them during times of sickness. It is never easy to hold evangelistic crusades in areas like Kahama where there is always a lot of public opposition and spiritual oppression when we take the truth of the Gospel into such spiritually dark places. The local police insisted we finish every night before sunset because of the increased danger after dark. However, I never cease to be amazed at the power of the Gospel to penetrate the spiritual darkness and the power of the Holy Spirit to draw people to Christ. I witnessed Muslims coming forward at



the invitation although friends and family members were literally trying to restrain them and hold them back. During the crusade 471 adults and youth came forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Thank you for helping us sow the good seed of the Gospel in the Uttermost.



## **Planting Churches in Brazil**

I have been traveling to preach crusades and evangelistic meetings in Brazil for several years. Although most of our meetings have been held in cities and large population centers, one of the pastors and churches we work with has a strong mission work in a very remote area of the country. I have traveled there on four occasions with Pastor Severino and members of his congregation to conduct several small crusades, and on each occasion a small number of people have been saved. Pastor Severino has established several preaching sites and started several mission churches in this area. On October 22 a small group gathered to pray over a plot of ground in Boqueirao, São Benedito Do Sul, where a new mission church would be built. Uttermost Evangelism is honored to partner with these new believers and provide the money for the construction of this new church building. Your faithful support of Uttermost Evangelism


