



## Evangelistic Youth Camp in Moldova

Carla and I arrived in Romania on October 18th to begin six weeks of ministry outreach in Romania, Moldova, Ukraine, and Germany. We are basing out of a mission house owned by Hope Baptist Church in Brasov, Romania. Just as we arrived in Romania, the news came that Romania had the worst COVID-19 outbreak in Europe and was the least vaccinated country in Europe, with less than 30% of the population fully vaccinated. Nevertheless, we drove from Romania to Moldova for our first outreach where we rented a camp facility for children and youth and conducted a youth outreach for 250 Moldovan teenagers and workers. The vast majority of the teenagers were unchurched, non-Christian youth. Local village churches invited the youth from surrounding high schools to attend a Christian youth conference at no cost to them. We housed, fed, and provided activities for them over the three days at a beautiful location. I led four evangelistic worship services over the three days, and over 100 youth responded by praying and coming forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord. It is very unusual to see this number of people come to Christ publicly in Europe. We were excited and humbled to see the Lord work in such a powerful way in this part of the world.







## Marriage Conference in Ukraine

In October, the Lord allowed Carla and me to return to the Luhansk region of Ukraine where two years ago I had conducted evangelistic crusades. We witnessed first hand the hardships the pastors and churches were under in this war torn place, an area on the front line of the war between Ukraine and Russia. Since the war began, Russia has taken over 43,000 square kilometers of Ukrainian territory which is over 7% of Ukraine's total land mass. Over 10,000 people have been killed and over 23,000 wounded since the conflict started. God put it on our hearts two years ago to come back and minister to the pastors and their families in this region. We held a pastors/wives marriage conference for ministers in the war zone who have been under great stress for several years because of the war. These pastors and their families are faithfully serving the Lord, their churches, and their countrymen in very dangerous times. We rented a beautiful facility in the middle of the forest where the couples could get away, relax, eat well, spend time with each other, fellowship with other couples, and receive encouragement for their marriages from the Word of God. All of the participants were amazed and excited over how nice everything was. The Lord used this

conference to refresh all of the couples both physically and spiritually. We had a wonderful time investing in the lives, ministries, and marriages of these choice servants of God.



## Ministering in America

In September Carla and I were on the road for over three weeks ministering in the United States, during which time we passed through 14 states. I conducted a four-day church revival, a one-day evangelistic Harvest Day, preached at a men's conference, and was the keynote speaker at a five-day missions conference. During these services 15 adults responded publicly giving their lives to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. We were also able to see and visit with some of our ministry partners and churches along our journey. It was a joy to minister in our own country.
