The Lord recently opened the door for Uttermost to conduct an evangelistic crusade in Pontotoc, Mississippi, in the large First Choice Bank Pavilion along the Tanglefoot Trail. Rev. Brian Sansing, pastor of Green Valley Baptist Church in Pontotoc, and other church members have ministered alongside us at several crusades in Africa over the past few years. Following some of those mission trips, he and I had discussed the possibility of hosting a crusade in Pontotoc using a format similar to the one we use in Africa and other foreign countries. We wanted a casual gathering where families would feel comfortable to come as they are and worship God together. It was a joy to see the facility filled each night with adults, youth, and children of all ages. The group Anchored along with members of the Green Valley praise team led us in evenings of powerful worship. Some people say this type of evangelistic outreach no longer works in America. However, as I preached the simple Gospel of Jesus Christ in Pontotoc, at each service, the Holy Spirit drew people publicly to receive Christ as Lord and Savior. The truth is God hasn't stopped using the gift of evangelists. He still blesses the proclamation of the Gospel, and He is still seeking and saving the lost. I pray more churches and pastors in America will get a vision for intentional outreach and evangelism in their local communities.

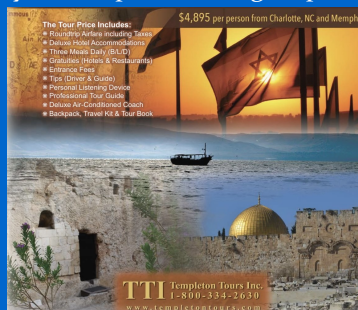




Holy Land Tour
