



Kigoma, Tanzania Crusades

Uttermost Evangelism recently took our crusade team to the Kigoma district in eastern Tanzania on the shores of Lake Tanganyika which is the longest and second deepest freshwater lake in the world. This district also borders the country of Burundi. We conducted three separate four night evangelistic crusades in the towns of Buhigwe, Kasulu, and Makere. We had originally scheduled these crusades to take place in these towns in 2021. Some of you may remember that while we were en route there, Carla and I got word that the government of Tanzania had rescinded our permission to conduct large meetings at that time because of an increase in Covid. Therefore, this was our second attempt to carry out crusades in these towns. The devil continued to fight us every step of the way. For example, our crusade team and equipment coming from Uganda were held up at the border for a week and missed the first crusade. I had to rent equipment in Tanzania and have it transported to the remote area of the first crusade venue. However, in the end the Lord gave us the victory. Our team and equipment finally arrived and the Lord blessed all the services in a wonderful way. During the twelve crusade services 2,201 people came forward publicly to accept Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. Thank you for partnering with us to take the life-changing Gospel of Jesus Christ to the ends of the earth.





Housing for Ukrainian Refugees

Since Russia launched a full-scale invasion of Ukraine in February of this year, millions of Ukrainians have fled their country and become refugees or have been displaced within Ukraine. Uttermost Evangelism has helped provide emergency housing, food, medical care, clothing, and direct financial assistance to many refugees in Romania, Moldova, and Ukraine. It has been eight months since the war began, and the scope of the war is expanding and intensifying with each passing day. Our primary focus at this point is to help provide more long-term housing assistance to help families begin to rebuild their lives. In some situations we have paid a year's rent in advance for displaced families in Ukraine. We are helping to renovate other facilities owned by churches and Christian ministries that have been used to house refugees. We have also helped purchase and renovate housing in Ukraine that the refugees can stay in and eventually own. The Lord has led us to focus most of our resources in helping eastern Ukrainian pastors and their families, most of whom have had their churches, homes, and towns destroyed. We are trying to help them resettle in western Ukraine. These pastors and their fami-

lies have the ability to minister to many of their countrymen as they regain stability in their own lives. Thank you for your sacrificial gifts to this emergency need.
