## **Mongolia Crusade**

This fall the Lord opened the door for us to conduct an evangelistic outreach in the country of Mongolia for the first time. Mongolia has a huge land mass with a small population, making it the lowest population density of any country in the world. Over 85% of Mongolian people identify as Buddhist and less than 2% of the population are Christian. We were able to partner with about 30 small churches in the capital city of Ulanbatar to host an evangelistic crusade for which we rented a large performing arts theater. We partnered with a diverse group of professional Mongolian musicians who led an awesome program of cultural performances prior to my sharing the Gospel each evening. One of the musicians was one of the most famous Mongolian pop stars. She has recently converted to Christianity and is an outspoken Christian witness. She helped us draw large crowds of lost people to the crusade and shared a powerful personal testimony prior to my sermon. Free tickets for the crusade were distributed, which allowed people to attend one night of the crusade. This allowed us to make sure more people were reached with the Gospel because the crowd was a different group of people each night. We had my "Salvation" book translated into Mongolian and 5,000 copies were printed and distributed. We also conducted one crusade service in a men's prison with the full group of Mongolian music artists joining us. In addition, Uttermost hosted a conference on evangelism which was attended by over 60 pastors and church leaders. Hundreds of Mongolians made a public decision to accept Jesus Christ as their Savior during the crusade services.





## **Moldova Youth Outreach**

Youth camps do not effectively reach youth in developed countries anymore because almost all youth in these countries have access to smart phones, computers and gaming devices along with a host of social media platforms. Summer camps seem boring to a generation of young people raised on technology. However, in developing countries, summer youth camps still draw young people. Moldova is one of the few European countries where there is still a window of opportunity to utilize youth camps as a viable ministry. Last year we decided to host two weeks of youth sports camps in Moldova, and they were a great success. This summer we worked with our Moldovan ministry partners to build on last year's successes and hosted two more weeks of youth volleyball camp. We had 320 different youths during the two weeks with 160 attending each week. These young people were from 14-18 years old and represented 36 co-ed volleyball teams from about 30 different cities across Moldova. Over 70% of the youths who attended these camps were unchurched and unsaved. Uttermost rented a camp and conference center where we housed and fed them in addition to providing organized sport competitions. Each day, we also led morning and evening chapel services which included Christian music and a series of messages on Spiritual Warfare from Ephesians chapter 6. I preached nine messages during each week of camp. Over

200 youth came forward publicly during the two weeks of camp to surrender their lives to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Your sacrificial gifts to missions through Uttermost Evangelism allowed us to cover the entire \$50 cost to fully sponsor each youth.
