



## First Crusade in Argentina

In October the Lord allowed me to travel to Buenos Aires, Argentina, to conduct a small crusade. Buenos Aires is a huge city with a population of over 13 million people. To put that in perspective, New York City has only about 8 million people. Although this was not my first visit to Argentina, it was my first visit since starting Uttermost. The Lord used pastor Marcos Navarro from Bolivia to open a door for our ministry in this beautiful country. Partnering with ten local churches to target a very specific neighborhood in the city, we rented a local gymnasium and turned the bleachers and ball court into a crusade venue. In the days leading up to the crusade, local churches twice saturated the community with flyers about the services. The church members also invited lost family members, friends, and coworkers to come with them to the crusade. We praise God the venue was packed with people for every service. As I extended a public invitation each evening for people to receive Christ as Savior and Lord, the open area in front of the crusade platform filled with people drawn by the Holy Spirit for salvation. We gave everyone who responded a copy of my Salvation book and a Bible, both in Spanish. The crusade was a great success, and since it ended, the local churches have been busy following up with those who made decisions.

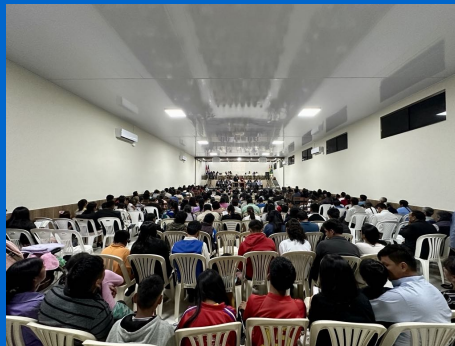




## Another Crusade in Bolivia

We have developed some wonderful church ministry partners in Bolivia who are helping us expand our evangelistic outreach in that country. It also served as an effective training ground and catalyst for local pastors and churches interested in learning how they can partner with us next year for an even larger event. The increased number of trained pastors and partner churches in Bolivia will not only allow us to conduct bigger crusades in Bolivia next year, but also will allow us to expand our outreach to new areas and cities around the country. Bolivia is a socialist country with most of the population being cultural Catholics who don't have

a personal relationship with Jesus Christ or understand what that means.



## Pastors Conference in Argentina

While I was in Argentina conducting an evangelistic crusade, I also had the wonderful opportunity to lead a conference for local pastors and church leaders. The theme of the conference was "How to live your life and conduct your ministry in such a way as to leave a lasting Godly legacy." I preached about characteristics from the life of John the Baptist that allowed him to be a man Jesus said was the greatest man ever born of woman and encouraged the pastors to implement these characteristics into their lives and ministries.
