



More Crusades in Mongolia

In April, I was able to travel to Mongolia for the third time to conduct evangelistic crusades. As I have shared in the past, Mongolia has a big land mass but a small population. Around half of the country's population lives in the capital city of Ulaanbaatar, and that is where our ministry and outreaches during our first two visits to Mongolia were concentrated. However, on this trip we were able to expand our outreach to the second and third largest cities of Mongolia. We partnered with pastors and churches in the cities of Erdenet and Darkhan to conduct evangelistic crusades in their cities. Both of these cities have a population of around 100,000 people. Around 90% of the people attending the crusade in Erdenet and around 50% of those attending in Darkhan were unbelievers. We had a good response at both crusades with a large number of people giving their lives to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Several months before these last crusades, our European coordinator traveled to Mongolia and conducted a conference for 50 Mongolian pastors and church leaders on how to disciple new believers. We even had some discipleship materials translated into the Mongolian language so they would have discipleship materials in their language. My salvation book has already been translated into Mongolian and a copy was given to everyone who attended each crusade.





European Mission Partner Conference

In March, Carla and I were invited to be keynote speakers at a conference in Hungary hosted by Mentoring Europe, a Christian nonprofit ministry focused on discipleship and leadership training among Christian leaders in European countries. We did not share at this conference as experts, but as fellow Christian co-laborers who have spent our entire adult lives seeking to follow Christ and share His Gospel around the world. The theme of the conference was “Overcoming Spiritual Apathy.” Christian leaders from various ministries and churches from eight different European countries attended the conference. Some of the participants were old friends and ministry partners of Uttermost Evangelism who have partnered with us in the past to do evangelistic outreaches in the countries where they live. However, some of the participants were people we had never met before and have never had the privilege to partner with. As an example, one attendee was the head of Child Evangelism Fellowship in Slovakia.

He leads a team of eight Child Evangelism Fellowship missionaries in his country and oversees all their outreach in that country. The conference was a wonderful opportunity to meet and invest in the lives of key Christian leaders and ministries from across Europe. During the conference several attendees expressed interest in their organizations partnering with Uttermost Evangelism in the future to help reach their countries with the Gospel.
