



Mission Team Joins Us For Uganda Outreach

Four members of Green Valley Baptist Church in Pontotoc, Mississippi, recently joined Carla and me for a multifaceted evangelistic outreach in Uganda. Most of the ministry was in the remote town of Bugadde where we conducted a three-day pastor and church leaders seminar for about 150 people. The seminar theme was "Doctrines of the Bible: Why we believe what we believe." The pastors and church leaders thoroughly enjoyed the training and were extremely excited and proud to receive their certificates of completion on the final day. Each day after the seminar, we fed the participants a good lunch. In addition, every afternoon before the crusade we conducted an evangelistic VBS for hundreds of children ranging in age from 2 to 12. The children loved learning and singing Christian songs with hand motions, hearing the Gospel message taught on their level, and coloring pictures they could take home that reinforced the daily lessons. Torrential rains during the days of the crusade affected our attendance, but we still had 564 public professions of faith during the four-day event. The faithful prayers and sacrificial gifts of our support team made all of this outreach possible.





More Outreaches in Brazil

In November, I was back in Brazil for two more crusades and evangelistic outreaches in five more prisons. Brazil is the largest country in South America, the fifth largest by land mass in the world, and the seventh largest country in the world by population with over 210 million people. The two crusades we conducted were some of our smallest this year as far as attendance, but still they were spiritually fruitful as we saw many come forward publicly to surrender their lives to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Between the two weekend crusades, my Brazilian team and I took a road trip to visit five Brazilian prisons, one of which I had visited once before, but the other four I had not. Monday through Friday we drove farther and farther away from the city of Recife. Each day I preached the Gospel in a different prison; then we would drive to the next prison, spend the night, minister the Word of God the next day in that prison and then drive farther to the next location. It was a very long week, and our journey took us hundreds of miles from where we had started. However, the prison ministry was very rewarding as we preached to thousands of inmates and saw hundreds of men surrender their lives publicly to

Jesus Christ. I also got to preach in two of our Brazilian partner churches, a ministry which is always a blessing. Thank you for helping us to continue our outreach to this vast and influential country.
