



## Expanding Crusades in Argentina

In 2024, we conducted our first crusade in Argentina in a suburb of Buenos Aires. This fall we were blessed to return to Argentina and conduct two more crusades. We were able to target another bedroom community around the vast city of Buenos Aires and travel to the beautiful Patagonia region to conduct a second crusade in Neuquen. Despite the threat of rain at both crusades, we still had good attendance and many people committed their lives to Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. One night at each crusade had to be moved to an alternate inside venue, but the rest of the services were able to be held outside at the intended locations. In Patagonia, the Lord also allowed us to conduct a conference for pastors and church leaders. The pastors in this region showed interest in helping us host more crusades in the future. We were also able to distribute my "Salvation" book in the Spanish language at all of the outreaches in Argentina. We are excited about the opportunity to continue to saturate Argentina with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.







## Back in Bolivia For Another Crusade

God has used my friendship and partnership with Pastor Marcos to open many doors for crusades and other evangelistic outreaches not only in Bolivia but also in other South American countries. While there, in addition to conducting another crusade and another pastors' conference, I also received invitations to speak in local high schools. During these events, we saw many people give their lives publicly to Jesus Christ. The strong partnership we have with local Bolivian pastors and

churches will ensure these new converts receive follow up, and many will become faithful members in these vibrant congregations.
