



First Crusades of 2026

In January, a new year of ministry kicked off with two crusades in Tanzania. At the first location, we also held a training for pastors and church leaders during the day. The conference, which was based on Ephesians 6, taught how to put on the Armor of God. Over 150 local pastors and church leaders completed the training and received certificates. The crusade in this location was a tremendous success with 1,638 public professions of faith during the four-night ministry. Although the second crusade was in a much smaller town than the first, we still had good attendance and response. God drew 1,334 souls into His forever family during the second event. We were excited to be able to place a copy of my Salvation book in the Swahili language in the hand of every person who was saved. We encouraged the people responding to the invitation each night to go home and immediately read the Salvation book so they could better understand the full biblical implications of accepting Christ as their Savior. The local pastors in both locations did a good job with mobilization for the crusade and immediately began following up with those who had made decisions for Christ. We continue to receive many good reports of those new believers' joining local churches and following through with baptism.





Mardi Gras Outreach in the Big Easy

For many years we have made an annual trip to New Orleans during Mardi Gras season to conduct street ministry on parade routes. This is a very challenging ministry requiring more than a little spiritual boldness, to which anyone who has joined us over the years can attest. However, it is a wonderful opportunity to take the light of the Gospel into the spiritual darkness of our modern humanistic and often godless society. If you have any doubts about the desperate spiritual condition of our country and its citizens, all you need to do is join us on one of these outreaches. You will want to weep over the spiritual condition of these people as Jesus wept over the crowds in Jerusalem when He walked this earth. Thousands of people line these parade routes from every age group, ethnic group, and socioeconomic background. But one obvious thing many of them have in common is that they are living their lives without a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. It is a startling reality that hits you over and over like a brick in the face. With compassion, and not a little fear and trembling, we handed out thousands of gospel tracts and copies of the Gospel of John to one person at a time. As we always do, we answered questions,

shared a loving smile, greeted people warmly, gave a deeper witness where possible, and generally tried to confront people lovingly with the reality of Jesus Christ and eternity.
