



First Outreach in Azerbaijan

Last year we did our first evangelistic outreach in Türkiye. The pastors there invited three pastors from Azerbaijan to come and be a part of the outreach. After meeting and ministering alongside these pastors in Türkiye, they extended an invitation for me to come this year and partner with them for an evangelistic outreach in Azerbaijan. In April, I traveled to Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan, where we conducted evangelistic services around the Easter holiday. Azerbaijan is around 97% Muslim and has only about 5,000 Protestant evangelical Christians in the entire country. We rented a beautiful historic cathedral in downtown Baku and conducted evangelistic services there. We developed a very powerful worship program utilizing traditional Azerbaijani dance, music, and drama to communicate the Gospel in a very culturally sensitive way. The services were packed and over 80% of the attendees were non-Christian. I preached the Gospel each night, and the sermons were translated live into Russian and Azerbaijani for the very diverse audience. In a country where it is hard to see one person saved, we saw as many as 70 public professions of faith at one service.





Our Last Crusades in Mongolia

Most of you know I have been conducting yearly crusades in Mongolia for the last 4 years. In April, we conducted our last crusades in that country. While Mongolia has a very large land mass, it has a small population concentrated in very few population centers. We have now conducted crusades in all of those main cities. Most of the country is a vast open mountainous or desert land with very scattered nomadic people tending animals. Our crusade coordinator will continue to visit the country to conduct training seminars for pastors and church leaders.

Although the final crusades were smaller than our previous ones in that country, they were effective. Our best ministry on this final outreach was an evangelistic youth event. We rented a large conference room of a downtown hotel in the capital city of Ulaanbaatar. We registered over 500 youth at the door and filled the venue to overflowing. The vast majority of the youth attending were not Christians. The Christian youth from the churches helped plan the outreach, led the program, sang songs,

played instruments, performed skits, and registered and helped minister to the non-Christian guests. It was a powerful and effective evening of outreach to the youth of Mongolia.
